GOSPEL (Luke 1:26-56)

The Birth of Jesus Foretold

In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee,

- to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. 28 Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, favoured woman! The Lord is with you!"

- 31 You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus.

- 44 When I heard your greeting, the baby in my womb jumped for joy.
- 45 You are blessed because you believed that the Lord would do what he said."
- 46 Mary responded, "Oh, how my soul praises the Lord.
- 47 How my spirit rejoices in God my Saviour!
- 48 For he took notice of his lowly servant girl, nd from now on all generations will call me blessed.

- He has scattered the proud and haughty ones.
